Participants have access to our automated technology to help guide them towards their retirement goals.





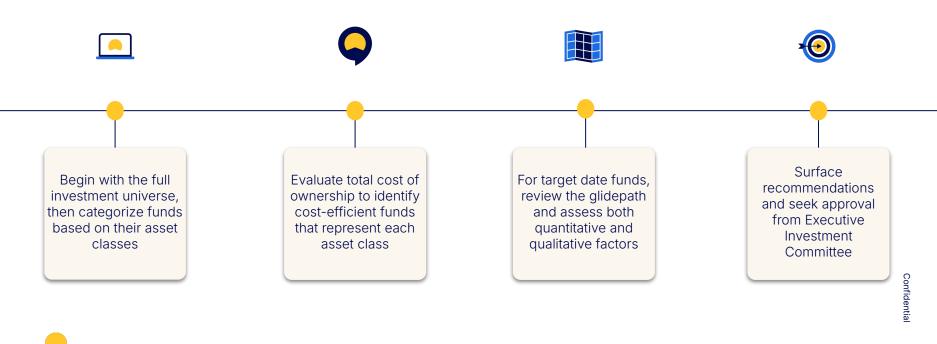


Mutual funds trade only once per day, after the market closes. A trade to buy or sell shares of a mutual fund is executed at the next available net asset value, which is calculated after the market closes, and may be different from the previous day's closing net asset value. This means that the price displayed in Betterment's interface is based on the net asset value at the time the market closed the prior day, but that the mutual fund will trade at the net asset value at market close on the day the transaction is executed. Glossary

Annualized Return: This is the average annual return over a period greater of a year, taking into account the effect of compounding. Annualized rate of return also can be called compound growth rate.

Expense Ratio: An expense ratio is the annual cost to hold an mutual fund and represents the fee charged by the fund company to cover the cost of managing and operating the mutual fund. Inception Date: An inception date is the track record of the fund, when the first launched and became available to investors.

Index: An investment index tracks the performance of many investments as a way of measuring the overall performance of a particular investment type or category.

Mutual Fund: A mutual fund is an investment vehicle that pools money from many investors to buy a diversified portfolio of stocks, bonds, or other securities, managed by a professional fund

Qualified Default Investment Alternative (QDIA): A QDIA is the default investment option chosen by a retirement plan for participants who don't make an investment election.

Target Date Fund (TDF): A TDF is a type of fund that automatically adjusts its asset allocation over time based on a participant's expected retirement date.
